

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

SOUTH JERSEY REGION – SPORTS CAR CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.

JANUARY 2021

The January 2021 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the home of Sue King on Wednesday evening January 6, 2021. The meeting was called to order by R.E., Jim Tornetta at 8:20PM.

Treasurers Report – No report.

Old Business – Jim Tornetta stated that he has signed the 2021 contracts with NJMP. J.D. King went over the 2021 road race schedule. April 16-18 is the Spring Fling to be held on the Lightning course. That Friday will feature a time trials event. The balance of the weekend will have an alternate driver's school along with qualifying and feature race. June 4-6 will be the Lightning Challenge on the Lightning course. July 16-18 is the Majors event on the Thunderbolt course. August 20-22 is the Summer Thunder event on the Thunderbolt course. October 22-24 is the Enduro and JRR events on the Thunderbolt course. The June, August and October events will include the MARRS series. The October event will feature three (3) fifty minute (50) enduros. J.D. King reminded all that qualifying times will set the field. J.D. King further stated that Terry Hanushek has agreed to remain as our licensing chairman.

Membership Report – John Hainsworth reported that we have 451 paid members to date. Those members include 90 competition licensed drivers and 9 competition novice permits. John further reported that Nelson Ledges may be coming back with the 24 hour enduro.

Autocross Report – Bill Richter reported that he has reached out to get prices on new laptops. J.D. King will check with his brother-in-law to see if he can help with this acquisition. Bill went on to report that Atlantic City will have their beer fest on June 4-5 and he believes Glasstown Brewery – one of our sponsors - will be in attendance. Perhaps we should bring a couple of our cars to this event. Bill further reported that he is in the process of applying for sanctions.

New Business - Jim Tornetta reported that Matt Wojtkowiak, our tech chief, would like to do our annual tech at Steve Thomas' shop, Triple T, in West Berlin in March. Steve will be contacted to set the date. It was felt that perhaps we could present our 2020 annual awards at the same time. Discussion centered on ideas for this presentation and a final determination will be made at the February Board meeting. Steve Kado reported that he will be in touch with Meg Meyer, our webmaster, to go over updates for our website. Josh Kuehne reported that he will order date cards for our 2021 track events.
