MAY 2021

The May 2021 meeting of the Board of Directors for the South Jersey Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. was held at the home of J.D. King on Wednesday evening, May 5, 2021. The meeting was called to order by R.E., Jim Tornetta at 8:00PM.

Treasurers Report - No Report.

Membership Report – John Hainsworth reported that we have 486 paid members to date.

Autocross Report - Bill Richter reported that the recent test and tune day held at Bader Field was a success. Our April 25th event had a total of 67 entrants and went off well in spite of having live timing problems. Discussion was held covering how best to access weekend memberships. Next event is scheduled for May 16th.

Road Rally Report – Jim Wakemen, Jr. reported that the Fall event which will be held in the northern part of the State is still on. This rally consists of two separate events.

Time Trials Report – Joshua Kuehne reported that he is still searching for a lift to move tire walls for our time trail scheduled for May 15th at Bader Field. So far entry looks good.

Race Report - J.D. King reported that our next race event, Lightning Challenger, is scheduled for June 4th, 5th and 6th will be a NeDiv and MARRS combined event. An advanced driver school (ADS) is planned for Friday, June 4th. There, also, be a time trials event scheduled at the end of the day on Saturday, June 5th.
