

New Jersey Road Racing Series 2018



The NJRRS is a Series intended to make racing at South Jersey Region SCCA Regional events conducted at New Jersey Motorsports Park safe, fun, competitive, and enjoyable.

NJRRS Class Championships are decided by total points accumulated in a class per the current scoring rules. Championship awards are given at (or after) the South Jersey Region awards banquet, usually held in the January following the season.

Eligibility and Scoring Rules:

All NJRRS and MARRS recognized classes are eligible for Championships.

NJRRS eligible races can be found in schedule below.

Series decals are available at Tech and Registration, they should be viewable from both sides of the car.

- Must participate in a minimum of three weekends, at least two at NJMP and one at Summit Point, to be eligible for the championship.
- May count the best 9 finishes from the 12 season races for the championship (3 drops).

All entries will be awarded NJRRS points according to the Points Schedule. Check the accuracy of your results for correct class, position, etc. Unless it's a points keeping error, no changes will be made without official revised T&S results.

Finishes must be in the same class. A start is defined as a competitor in the entered car having turned a wheel on the track during any race session of the event.

Class Points:

Additional class points will be awarded according to class size. Points are based on the number of cars in your class minus your finish position. If you are DNF, DNS or DSQ the 0 points are awarded.

example:

5 cars in your class and you finish 2nd would be -
26 pts for 2nd + (5 cars in class - 2nd place)
26 + (5 - 2) = 29 points

June 1-2 --- Lightning Challenge – Lightning June

*July 27-28 --- MARRS 5 – Summit Point *away**

Aug 10-11--- Summer Thunder – Thunderbolt

*Sept 28-29 --- MARRS 9 – Summit Point *away**

Oct 26-27 --- Jersey Road Racing Classic - Lightning

NOTE:

NJRRS feature race grids at NJMP are set by qualifying race finishing orders.

NJRRS feature race grids at Summit Point are based on fastest times in qualifying races (per MARRS rules).

Tie breakers, points loss from exclusions, disqualifications, protests, etc. may parallel GCR National event rules. The South Jersey Region SCCA will rule on situations not covered specifically in the GCR.
