Each COURSE RALLY will have a featured format such T-Rule, Lettered Route Instructions, Onto Rule or other format. The other course, called TOURING RALLY, will be straight forward with no traps. The COURSE RALLY will have classes E, L, S and N. The TOURING RALLY will have 2 classes of S and E/L. L cars will have their scores multiplied by .6 for a handicap. Each rally will also have any special class the contestants wish to form. The special classes can be formed having a common bond of car make, club, family, friendship, workplace or any other identifiable bond. There will be Year End Awards and Champions declared for the rallyists who accumulate the most points in their class during the 2008 series. Nine of the ten rallies will use JG Cook's Bar and Grill as headquarters. The Rallies are open to all types of cars and small trucks. Each vehicle will be piloted by two member teams consisting of a driver and navigator. The vehicles will travel on back country roads at safe legal speeds.
